Symphony Mobile works seamlessly with Aimetis Symphony and/or E3200/E7000 Series appliances. It is available as a download on **Google Play** and Apple's **App Store**. Symphony Mobile consists of two items: an application for your smartphone or tablet and a server component called the Mobile Bridge. The Symphony Mobile Bridge server component can be installed on the same Symphony server machine or a different one.
